Vocational Education and Training in Schools

VETiS funded Certificate I or II courses

Funded pre-apprentice-trainee OHS and skills introduction before committing to higher level fee for service study or school-based apprentice-trainee applications.

• VET fee for service Cert III, IV or Diploma courses: Delivery and location of courses vary and follow.

Off campus – one day per week studies 12-24 months Attend school 4 days per week. Online homework between lessons

Online

Some virtual programs have weekly trainer Microsoft Teams meetings while others are online unit completion with trainer contact via email.

On Campus

Training providers may have agreements to deliver courses with different school campus locations, set times during their school timetable and calendar year. The school provides the location, the training provider delivers the course and issues the qualification.

• School-based Apprentice or Traineeships
Shared to Apprentice Connect Australia Providers (ACAPs)
Job Board and sent directly to school ILO or Career team
members to forward to senior student and parent emails.

Other RTO or Employers directly contact schools with current vacancies via email for share to the senior student community.

Check student school and parent emails weekly:

Suggestion: Check emails start, middle and end of each week.
