Each Monday we will have a GP on site to provide our secondary students with access to free and confidential healthcare.





Around our school you will see a QR which directs you to this page and the relevant appointment booking processes below.

All secondary students will be able to visit the Health clinic. Our GP will provide you with health information, advice and treatment. You can go to the GP for any physical or mental health concerns, including about your sexual and reproductive health.
