As a student of an Excellence Program you, as a student and parent, also agree to abide by these expectations both in the classroom and in the community:

- 1. All students meet their academic requirements for their specific Summit program.
- Academic Summit To achieve and maintain at least a 'B' standard in English, Science, Maths, History, SOSE and Critical Thinking/Entrepreneurial Studies and no less than a 'C' standard in all other subjects.
- **Dance Summit** To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in Dance Summit and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects.
- **Sport Summit including Basketball, AFL, Rugby and Netball** To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in High Performance Sport and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects. An annual review of students sporting ability will be completed to determine eligibility for continuation into the next year level.
- **STEAM Academy** To achieve and maintain at least a 'B' standard in Maths, Science and Critical Thinking/Robotics and no less than a 'C' Standard in all other subjects.
- **Music Summit** To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in Music and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects
- **Triple Threat Summit** To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in Triple Threat Summit and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects.
- 2. All students will need to achieve a 'Very Good' or 'Excellent' rating for effort and behaviour in their area of expertise.
- 3. All students will follow school rules at all times and display exemplary behaviour and attitude across all areas of learning both, within the school and in the community. Please note that suspensions will result in students being moved to a provisional status and immediate formal monitoring of students for a period of time.
- 4. All students will participate in the school programs in the area/s for which they were accepted into the program.
- 5. All students will engage in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities afforded to them, as a part of their excellence position. Exemptions from such activities will only occur after thorough negotiation between parent/guardian and excellence coordinator.
