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## SELECTIVE ENTRY PROGRAM

### STUDENT CONTRACT

To be involved in Merrimac State High School's Summit Program there are high standards and expectations that are required to be maintained.

By signing below, you agree to commit to the following:

- 1) **Academic Summit** - To achieve and maintain at least a 'B' standard in English, Science, SOSE and Critical Thinking/Entrepreneurial Studies and no less than a 'C' standard in all other subjects.
  - Dance Summit** - To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in Dance Summit and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects.
  - Sport Summit** - To achieve and maintain a 'B' standard in High Performance Sport and no less than a 'C' in all other subjects.
  - STEAM Academy** – To achieve and maintain at least a 'B' standard in Maths, Science and Critical Thinking/Robotics and no less than a 'C' Standard in all other subjects.
- 2) Attend a minimum of 95% of all classes at Merrimac State High School. Report to the school any extended absences (one week or longer) as early as possible.
- 3) Achieve a B (Very Good) or A (Excellent) for effort and behaviour across all subjects on all report cards.
- 4) Maintain an excellent standard of behaviour at all times. This includes behaviour during break times on campus, at events, competitions, excursions and in the wider community.
- 5) Adhere to the Student Code of Conduct and the school's values of Respect, Responsibility and Reliability.
- 6) Be on time and prepared for all classes.
- 7) Maintain a high standard of dress as per the Merrimac State High School uniform policy.
- 8) Participate in all activities in a safe and controlled manner and wear all protective equipment and activity uniform required.
- 9) Ensure all academic obligations are met for all of your classes as a priority over any Summit event.
- 10) Avoid doing anything that could negatively affect the reputation of the Summit program

A minor breach of these standards will result in a formal warning provided in writing and you will be required to improve your level of performance in the identified area/s. Ongoing minor breaches or a major incident will result in a review of your position of the program. The Summit Management Board will collectively decide on an outcome/consequence and review your place in the program. A formal outcome will be provided in writing, after which, any further demonstration of negligence will mean your position in the Summit Program will be terminated.
