SECTION 2: DOCUMENTATION

In order to apply for entry into a Summit Program, students must supply by Wednesday 21 February 2024:

- 2025 Expression of Interest to Enrol Form
- Completed Selective Entry Application Form
- Last 2 Report Cards AND Year 5 NAPLAN results (where available)
- Other evidence of achievement i.e. competition achievements, Principal's Award, school certificates and representative teams (State, national).

In addition to the above, video auditions will be required for **Music and STEAM**. Once you have submitted a complete application a link will be sent to you to upload your audition video.

Academic Summit entry exams will take place at the school. An invitation will be sent to you once we have a completed application.

Dance Summit and Triple Threat will be an in-person audition held at Merrimac State High School. Once you have submitted a complete application an invitation will be sent to you to attend the audition in either the 3.30pm or 4.30pm session.

Sport Summit and specialist Basketball, AFL, Rugby and Netball will be an in-person trial at Merrimac State High School. Once you have submitted a complete application an invitation will be sent to you to attend the trial in either the 3.30pm or 4.30pm session. Please note if applying for one of the specialist programs your trial will be with the Sport Summit applicants.

Written applications and all documentation should be submitted via email to enrolments@merrimacshs.eq.edu.au. No applications will be assessed without all portfolio documentation. Upon completion of the selection process, staff and specialist teachers will decide on the suitability of each applicant. Once all applications have been processed, applicants will be notified by email of their result.



SECTION 3: FEES

Upon acceptance in a program, an annual fee is payable in addition to the student resource scheme every year that the student is part of the program. The fee is \$100 per program. Please note, Music Summit will be a 1 semester course and as such, will incur a fee of \$50.

Program fees must be paid prior to the commencement of the school year. If the fees are not paid by the due date, it will be concluded that the student no longer wishes to participate in the program.

SECTION 4: REVIEW PROCESS

Students participating in the Selective Entry Program will be reassessed at the conclusion of each reporting cycle until the end of Year 9 by the Summit Management Board.

This review process is to ensure students are meeting the expectations of the program, and to provide additional support for students in order to help them achieve success. Should the student not maintain the standards of the program, they may be at risk of losing their place in the program and their Summit fees forfeited.

Students and parents will sign a Summit Program Contract at their enrolment interview outlining their responsibilities as part of these courses. Any breach of the contract may result in the student being withdrawn from their program/s.
